Susan May Warren Testimony

I'm very fortunate to have grown up in a Christian family and a Bible-believing church. I accepted the Lord at a young age, and affirmed my trust in the Lord for salvation through Baptism at the age of twelve. In my teen years, I served on numerous missions teams, from inner-city locations to Indian reservations and rural churches. At the age of twenty-one, I surrendered to the call of to serve God full-time on the mission field, and pursued this by attending Urbana '87. While serving as a program director at a camp in northern Minnesota, I met my husband. After graduating from the University of Minnesota in '91, with a B.A in Mass Communication and English, we moved to Tennessee where my husband earned his B.S from Moody Bible Institute's School of Aviation in Tennessee. Following the Lord's call to Russia, in 1994 we moved to Khabarovsk, Russia with the Navigators to serve with CoMission Project. Following our first four years, we returned as career missionaries with SEND International. The Lord sent us home in 2003 to live on the North Shore of Minnesota where I currently write full-time while my husband runs a hotel and our children finish school. Someday we hope to return to the mission field.

Statement of Faith
